

Dear Competition Organizers

We would like to thank you for your patience with the upcoming competition season. There have been many changes as you are all aware and there will likely continue to be changes as the new competition structure gets "tweaked" through everyone's learning of the new system.

We would encourage you to read all of the information attached to this email. In it you will find a quick reference of the changes to the competition structure, a Date Notification Form (New for all disciplines & levels of competition), Discipline charts to help guide you to the correct level of sanctioning that you will register your competition for, and the standard Officials Approval Form, Prize List Approval Form and Insurance Certificate form that normally accompany your competition registration packages from the SHF.

Please pay close attention to the discipline charts. There have been changes to sport license requirements that you will have to be aware of, most importantly Bronze Level now requiring a sport license. There are changes to collections of Drug Fees & Testing at EVERY level of competition, and a Levy and affiliate fee being charged for Dressage competitions. Most of these changes will affect your entry forms & prize lists, so you must be aware of the information that you will need to add to your packages going out to your exhibitors.

New rule books are expected to be ready in February and will be available on the Equine Canada website.
