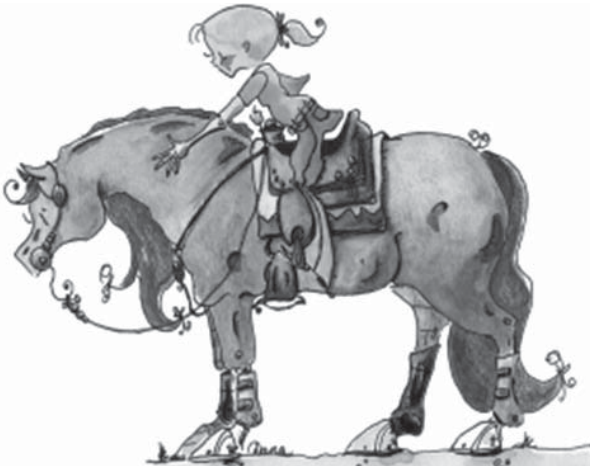

RULES & REGULATIONS

1. The show will follow the SHF Heritage Rules. Open to all Saskatchewan Equine Youth and Light Horse 4-H members.
2. The Moose Jaw Exhibition Grounds is a NON SMOKING AREA. THERE ARE NO EXCEPTIONS!
3. All registrations must be in by August 1st, 2010. Late registrations will be subject to a \$20 fee per rider. Make all cheques payable to the SHF.
4. The stall clean out fee is applicable to ALL horses. No trailer tying. Please include a separate cheque for \$20 for clean out. It will be returned once the area has been cleaned and checked.
5. No bedding will be supplied. Please bring your own, or buy locally.
6. No Stallions will be allowed.
7. Refunds given with a Vet / Doctor certificate only.
8. ASTM/SEI Helmets are MANDATORY to ALL riders in ALL events.
9. A rider may enter any class that s/he wishes. 4-H riders may enter both 4-H classes and Open classes, but may collect points for Team awards from only one source. A rider registered under Cloverbud may not enter any Junior C or Rookie. Riders nominated to the Heritage Circuit will receive Heritage points for the SHF year-end awards.
10. With fewer than five entries in a class, it may be combined with another age category at the discretion of the Show Committee
11. Exhibitors upon entry will hold harmless and indemnify the SK Horse Federation, SK 4-H Council, and the Youth Equestrian Tournament, its volunteers, participants and management for any and all liabilities or personal injury to rider, horse or spectator resulting from participation in the Youth Equestrian Tournament.
12. The judge may close the entry gate for a class as required. Tack changes will be kept to a minimum.
13. No unsportsmanlike conduct will be tolerated from exhibitor, coach or parent. Violators may be asked to leave.
14. Foul or abusive language or unnecessary cruelty to animals WILL NOT be tolerated.
15. All participants will randomly be divided into teams. Team points are earned from participation in activities, games and from competition points.
16. All participants may nominate a participant for the Youth Sportsmanship Award decided on team building, participation and competition.
17. The TOP record book from each 4H Club may be entered. Record books to be sent to South East Regional Specialist - Melodi Hawkesford-Lee by August 9th 2010.
18. All 4-H contestants must show their record book at time of registration. These will be kept in the show office on display for the weekend.
19. Stall Decoration contest is open to all. No entry fee. Stalls will be judged on cleanliness, conduct, cooperation of members, coaches and leaders, and the quality of the display.
20. The group ride (Drill Team) is done to music with a 5 minute time limit. No entry fee charged. A group must provide own music in a CD format. Group participation is to be indicated on the entry form. Group to have a minimum of 4 horses. To be judged on grooming, 20 pts; dress, 20 pts; uniformity of horse & rider, 20 pts; performance of group, 40 pts.
21. High Point awards will be given to the High Point Arabian, Quarter Horse, Appaloosa, Non-Registered, Pony Club members and Saskatchewan Paint Horse Club members. Saskatchewan Paint Horse Club members and Pony Club please remit copy of membership.
22. Those requesting special stall allocations must send in entries as a group.
23. Early arrival: (prior to Friday) and Camping ground requests must register separately and pay with the Moose Jaw Exhibition office.
24. Competitors may compete in one of the following age groups:
SHF Age Categories: - Junior C: 11 and under as of Jan. 1, 2010
- Junior B: 12 to 14 years as of Jan. 1, 2010
- Junior A: 15-17 years as of Jan. 1, 2010
4H Age Categories: - Cloverbud: 6-8 as of Dec. 31, 2009
- Junior 9-12 as of Dec. 31, 2009
- Intermediate: 13-15 as of Dec. 31, 2009
- Senior: 16-21 as of Dec. 31, 2009

Classes will be split into age categories if there are too many in the class.

***4-H Rookie: Any age but has never received 1st to 8th placing in any show**

Matters not covered in the Rules may be brought to the attention of the Show Committee for clarification and/or ruling. The Show Committee's decision shall be final.

BIOGRAPHIES

Barrel Racing: Sandy was born and raised in Kennedy, Saskatchewan, and now lives near Weyburn. She has been around horses all her life, and has done very well in all disciplines. Along with many other riding awards, a high light as a teen was winning the Provincial Horsemanship award and attending the National Finals in Vegas as the Saskatchewan Rodeo Queen. She now trains Barrel Horses and competes in both Canada and the United States.

Dressage: Shannon Sluser, Glenavon is a top Dressage competitor in Canada, having been named to the National Dressage Team Long List for 2008 & 2009. She is an excellent teacher and will introduce the basics of riding a dressage test as well as the skills needed for all basic horse riding on the flat.

Hunters: Leslie Hierath of Saskatoon has a lifetime of experience with horses. An active competitor and now a certified coach, she works especially with beginning riders and young athletes, introducing them to jumping techniques needed to do a hunter course.

Trail: Sandra Assman & Stormy Schlamp are well known as coaches and trainers for Tail and Pleasure Horses. Sandy has written the Trail Horse Judges' Manual that is used to train and certify Trail Horse Judges. Sandy is also the Master Course Conductor for the Western Coaching Certification program in Saskatchewan. She has recently opened a new training facility at Pilot Butte just outside of Regina.

CHAMPIONSHIPS

Open Division and 4H Championships will be awarded to the horse/rider combination with the highest points accumulations as follows:

Division Championships

Tournament Division Champion and Reserve Champion must have competed in at least two Divisions. (excluding the Dressage & Equitation Divisions).

Hunter Division – Champion & Reserve: 2' Cross Pole, 2'3" Hunter, and 2'6" Hunter

Hack Division – Champion & Reserve: Road Hack, Show Hack and English Pleasure

Western Speed Division – Champion & Reserve: Barrels, Poles and Keyhole

Western Performance Division – Champion & Reserve: Western Pleasure, Trail and Reining

The following Division Champions must have competed in both classes

English Equitation Division – Champion & Reserve: English Equitation Over Fences and English Equitation On The Flat

Western Equitation Division – Champion & Reserve: Western Stock Seat Equitation and Showmanship

Dressage Division – Champion & Reserve: Walk Trot and Training Level

4-H AWARDS

4-H Cloverbud Champion: High point totals from Showmanship, English Pleasure or Western Pleasure, English Equitation or Western Stock Seat, Barrels, Poles, Keyhole, Trail

4-H Rookie Champion: Showmanship, English Pleasure or Western Pleasure, English Equitation or Western Stock Seat, Trail

4-H Grand Aggregate: Total Points accumulated from the following classes: Judging, Western or English Pleasure; English Equitation on the flat or Western Stock Seat and Trail.

Breed High Point: Western Pleasure, English Pleasure, Trail, Showmanship, and one either Road or Show Hack

Pony Club High Point: English Equitation on the flat, English Equitation over fences, Highest jumped hunter class and average Dressage score

COLOUR TEAM CHAMPIONS

Moose Jaw Toyota Team Meltdown: 4 classes – *Champion cooler and Reserve Halter:* Qualifying riders come from the top two placings of each Colour Team in Western Pleasure, English Pleasure, Stockseat Equitation and English Equitation on the Flat. Team Points gained in the Meltdown classes will have a multiplying factor of x2 for the FINAL team Aggregate Standings.

COLOUR TEAM STANDING: All Riders will be randomly assigned to a Color Team upon entry to the Tournament. Moose Jaw Toyota Team Tournament Gold Champions, Silver and Bronze Reserve Champions to be declared from total points accumulated by each team throughout the Tournament. Event points to be accumulated from the following: Open or 4-H Class placings; Team Meltdown Classes, Team Building Games including Sundae Race and more TBA.

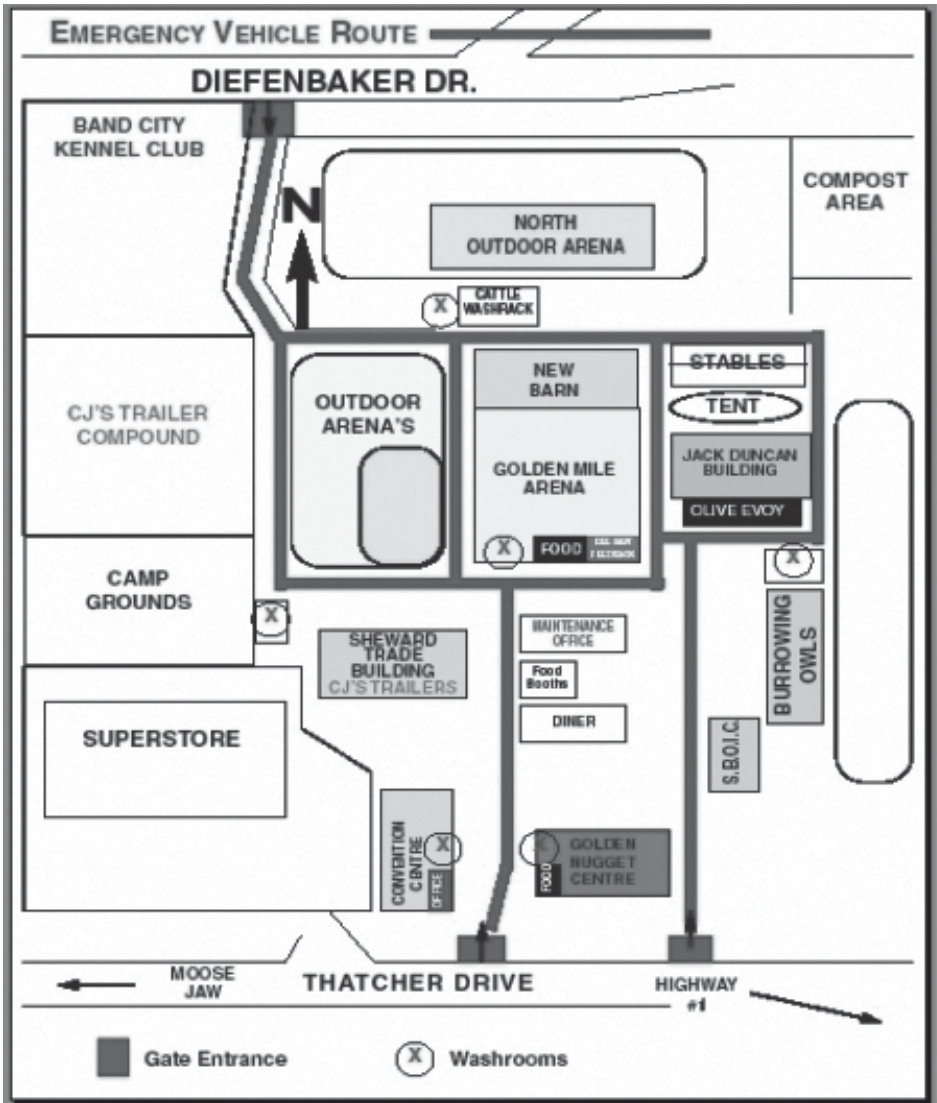
